

State Testing Data for Licensure

To obtain licensure, the State of Oklahoma requires all teacher candidates to pass two state tests. The Oklahoma Subject Area Test (OSAT), is taken during the junior year. Candidates must pass the OSAT as a requirement to begin clinical practice. The third test, the Oklahoma Professional Teachers' Exam (OPTE), is taken during the senior year. Candidates must pass the OPTE as a requirement for program completion. The EPP requires candidates to pass all three exams as a requirement for program completion and graduation. The passing score on all three exams is 240.
